ENGLISH FOR CITIZENSHIP

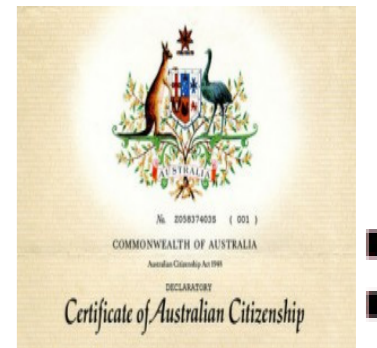

The English for driving course will help learner and local residents navigate Australian road culture.

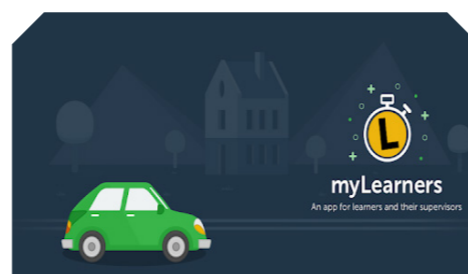
